

Saint Theodora of Vasta hailed from Arcadia? During the 10th century, bandits often raided this part of Greece. Determined to defend her village, she disguised herself as a man and went into battle. Tragically killed, her last words were, "Let my body become a church, my hair a forest of trees, and my blood a spring to water them."

A church was built on the sight of her grave. Soon after, a river miraculously rerouted itself to flow under the church. Then trees began to grow from the roof, but the roots are not visible anywhere in or on the church.
